

The British Hydrological Society has an allocation of funds for travel grants, usually for members who are presenting papers. These fall into two categories:

- Grants which are available from BHS general funds to help mainly young members with the cost of attending meetings.
- Grants from the Exeter Fund, which are used to help members attending IAHS meetings.

Applicants are required to complete Part A, and to ask a Reviewer to complete Part B. Successful applicants are expected to produce a short report on their experience in attending the meeting for the BHS *Circulation* magazine.
